

## **OTHER AWARDS**

### **OUTGOING PRESIDENT'S GIFT**

Adopted October 1972

All outgoing Presidents should receive a plaque in appreciation for service. This plaque will be presented on the last day of the Annual Meeting following the election of new officers. In the event that it is not possible to make a presentation at that time, it will be made at the next meeting of the National Council Executive Committee.

### **SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS**

Adopted February 11, 1982

At the discretion of the National Council Executive Committee, special awards of recognition may be made to individuals who have made significant contributions to the objectives and achievements of the National Council. These may be for service over a long period of time, or for a significant single contribution, to a non-member employee of the Social Security Administration, or to an individual outside the Social Security Administration. Nominations for such awards may be made at any time by a Regional Association or by the National Council Executive Committee. The basis for the nomination should be clearly stated and submitted to the President of the National Council for action by the Executive Committee. These awards may be in the form of framed certificates or resolutions of appreciation, or a plaque. The awards may be presented at a time and place deemed suitable by the Executive Committee.

### **CERTIFICATES OF APPRECIATION**

Adopted August 1982

Framed Certificates of Appreciation should be presented at the final business session of the Annual Meeting to the retiring National Council Executive Committee members.
