NWMA Scholarship Application Form: A photocopy of the scholarship application form is acceptable.

Essay: Essay of **no more than 400 words** on a topic of applicant's choice that demonstrates how this scholarship will further your goals and academic pursuits.

Written Recommendation/Character Reference: Please submit one written recommendation/character reference from a teacher, counselor, community leader or supervisor. The letter of recommendation should provide the selecting committee with a personal insight of the applicant and address why the reference feels the applicant is deserving of the scholarship.

Transcript: The transcript must show a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on an unweighted 4.0 scale. An official transcript is not required; photocopies of transcripts are acceptable.

- ***Graduating High School Seniors:*** Submit your most recent secondary school (high school) transcript, including current school year grades that verifies at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- ***Undergraduates Students:*** Submit your most recent post-secondary transcripts that verifies at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Transcripts from all colleges attended **MUST** be included.

Accomplishments: On a separate page, please provide a list of awards, extracurricular and community service activities for the past four years. Briefly describe and provide enough information so the scholarship review committee will understand your accomplishments. **Include relevant dates and average time spent at each activity.**
